CITIC Seram Achieved the 2016 MIGAS Safety Award Issued by the Indonesian Government

CITIC Seram Energy Limited ("CITIC Seram"), a subsidiary of CITIC Resources Holdings Limited, achieved the 2016 MIGAS Safety Award issued by Directorate General of Oil and Gas, Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources ("MIGAS") Indonesia in August, 2016.

The Seram Island Non-Bula Block operated by CITIC Seram recorded more than 6 million man-hours without a lost-time injury between 12 June 2013 and 31 March 2016, surpassing the safety standard set forth by the local government which requires at least 5 million man-hours without a lost-time injury for medium-sized upstream oil exploitation companies. CITIC Seram was presented with the safety award by MIGAS in recognition of its outstanding achievement.



The MIGAS Safety Award is an annual award made for companies engaging in the upstream and downstream oil and gas industry in Indonesia.
